## Elections Regulations 2016 (Amendment No. 1)

#### 1. Objective

The objective of this Regulation is to amend the *Exclusion for Safety Reasons Regulations 2019* made under sections 41 of the *Governance, Academic and Student Affairs Statute 2013*.

#### 2. Commencement

This amending Regulation will come into effect on the day it is made by the Council under Section 54 of the *Governance, Academic and Student Affairs Statute 2013*.

#### 3. Amendments

Part 2 Division 2 Regulation 9 Sub-regulation (1) is removed and replaced with:

- (1) A person may apply to the returning office to be included on a voter's roll if-
  - (a) the person's name is not on the voter's roll; and
  - (b) the person believes that the person is entitled to be included on the voter's roll.

Part 3 Regulation 12 Sub-regulation (5) b is removed and replaced with:

b. is resident in Australia and is enrolled in a minimum of 0.5 fraction of the full time study load and meets one of the category requirements of Part 5 Regulation 3 Subregulation a of the Academic Board Regulations 2021.

Part 7 Division 1 Regulation 36 is removed and replaced with:

This Regulation applies to elections to the Academic Board and the Council and any other prescribed University body.
