Student Misconduct Regulations 2019 (Amendment No. 2)

1. Objective

The objective of this Regulation is to amend the *Student Misconduct Regulations* 2019 made under sections 41 of the *Governance, Academic and Student Affairs Statute* 2013.

2. Commencement

This amending Regulation will come into effect on the day it is made by the Council under Section 54 of the *Governance, Academic and Student Affairs Statute 2013.*

3. Amendments

Part 3 Regulation 11 Sub-regulation (5) is removed and replaced with:

(5) Senior officers may also take any other action reasonable in the circumstances, including, where they consider it necessary for the maintenance of good order or to prevent the continuation of student misconduct, temporarily withdrawing permission for the student to participate in a University activity, use or enter all or particular University premises or facilities for 5 University business days.

Part 4 Regulation 12 Sub-regulation (1) a. is removed and replaced with:

 a) the Chief Student Officer, or their nominee, who will act as the panel Chair except in cases involving alleged Research Misconduct where the Deputy Vice-Chancellor, Research & Impact, or their nominee, will act as the panel Chair; and

Insert the following after Regulation 19 Sub-regulation (1)(f)

g) a restorative sanction that is appropriate and proportionate in all the circumstances.

Insert the following after Regulation 19 Sub-regulation (2)(m)

n) a restorative sanction that is appropriate and proportionate in all the circumstances.
